

### 1. Program Summary

The Commonwealth Government has invested \$10 million in the Lindenow Valley Water Security Scheme (the Scheme) to assist Lindenow Valley Irrigators construct major on-farm water infrastructure to improve security of supply that enhances their long-term drought resilience.

The Scheme provides up to 50 per cent, to a maximum of \$2 million per farming enterprise, to eligible Lindenow Valley Irrigators for costs associated with the planning, design and construction of on-farm water storage, bore construction and the installation of water supply pipelines and pumping infrastructure (directly for water transfer to storage facilities and mains back to the farm distribution point) to increase water security and improve resilience to drought.
